Elm Farm


Boundaries :

From the railway bridge downstream to the start of the mill section.

Entrances:

From the public bridle path to ash ford or the metal gate beside the bungalow at Elm Farm. Parking is now only allowed on 'Tilt Road'. Please be aware of parking restrictions

Be aware – Don't use carbon fibre rods or poles near overhead power lines.




Mill Section

Boundaries:

The extent of the water is the Mill field, downstream to the ditch just over the Mill Field fence. Fishing is only on the Mill Field bank. Fishing is not permitted from the road side bank.

Entrance:


Over the bridge at Cobham Mill. Please lock the gate behind you when crossing the bridge.



Plough Meadows

The extent of the water is the left bank downstream from the downstream fence at Downside Bridge to the fence opposite the stile at Pointers. Access is gained only by the stiles at either end of the public footpath. The first, second, third, fourth and fifth fields may be fished. The right bank from St Andrews church car park inclusive to the downstream side of the ditch opposite pointers. Parking for the whole of Plough Meadows is in the lay-by adjacent to Downside Bridge. Access is by the style and by the steps beside bridge, as per map.

There are now 6 car parking spaces at Cobham Court farm buildings for members to use on a first come basis. Please be considerate regarding noise as there are to tenants in residence nearby.



Cobham Court


Boundaries :


The extent of the water is the right hand bank downstream from the weir.

Entrance:

Access to the water is via the footpath off Anvil lane. When walking upstream, please lock the gate behind you. Parking is permitted behind the allotments in Anvil lane and in Painshill Park car park at opening times.

Be aware – Don't use carbon fibre rods or poles near overhead power lines.
